Daedalus & Icarus, 2025

Inspired by the Greek myth of Daedalus and Icarus, this work celebrates human ingenuity, courage, and the timeless desire to transcend limitations in the pursuit of freedom.

Four Winds I – Boreas

Inspired by Boreas, the North Wind, this work embodies strength, resilience, and the unseen force of nature.

Inspired by the Trojan War, this work reflects the price of ambition, reminding us that every victory carries the weight of sacrifice.

Inspired by the Palace of Knossos, this work captures the silent geometry of a civilization where architecture became memory.

Inspired by Poseidon, God of the sea, this work captures the eternal rhythm of the waves, where strength and serenity exist in perfect balance.

Inspired by the eternal movement of the sea, this work evokes the quiet dialogue between water, wind, and time.

Alcyone's Eggs, 2025

Inspired by the myth of Alcyone, whose love was transformed into hope. According to Greek mythology, Zeus calmed the winter sea for a few days so the halcyon bird could safely hatch her eggs, giving birth to the "Halcyon Days"—a timeless symbol of peace, renewal, and hope after the storm.

Echoes of Silence, 2025

Inspired by the quiet rhythm of nature, this composition is built from countless small gestures that come together as one. Like ripples carried by the wind or waves shaping the shore, it reminds us that harmony is created through repetition, patience, and time.

Inspired by the birth of Aphrodite from the sea, this artwork transforms organic marine forms into a sculptural composition. Shells, pebbles and flowing textures celebrate beauty, harmony and the timeless elegance of nature.

Aphrodite's Garden III, 2026

Inspired by the birth of Aphrodite from the sea, this artwork transforms organic marine forms into a sculptural composition. Shells, pebbles and flowing textures celebrate beauty, harmony and the timeless elegance of nature.

Aphrodite's Wreath, 2026

Inspired by Aphrodite, goddess of beauty and the sea, this sculptural composition recalls a ceremonial wreath formed by shells shaped over time by the waves. It celebrates harmony, renewal and the quiet elegance of nature.

Aphrodite's Blossom, 2026

Inspired by Aphrodite, goddess of beauty and the sea, this sculptural composition evokes a flower emerging from the sea. Its layered form symbolizes beauty born from nature and the eternal cycle of creation.

Aphrodite's Circle, 2026

Inspired by Aphrodite, goddess of beauty and the sea, this circular form represents continuity, unity and the endless rhythm of the waves. Each sculpted element becomes part of a balanced and timeless whole.

Eternal Circles, 2025

Inspired by the endless rhythm of nature, *Eternal Circles* explores the silent movement of time. Every engraved curve represents a moment that expands into another, reminding us that every ending becomes a new beginning. Through texture, light and shadow, the composition celebrates continuity, harmony and the quiet beauty of life's infinite cycle.

Shadow Form, 2025

Shadow Form explores the silent presence of geometry. Carved arches and intersecting planes emerge from a deep black surface, where light becomes part of the composition itself. The work speaks about strength, balance and the hidden structures that shape our perception.

A sculptural tribute to Apollo, where light becomes an essential part of the artwork.

Inspired by the Oracle, this sculptural lamp transforms light into a symbol of intuition and inner reflection.

Inspired by Ares, the Greek god of courage and strength, this sculptural lamp embodies silent power through its bold and primitive form.

Inspired by Phrixus, whose journey on the Golden Ram became a symbol of salvation and new beginnings, this work reflects resilience guided by destiny.

Inspired by Diomedes, one of the bravest heroes of the Trojan War, this sculptural vase embodies courage, resilience, and the strength to move forward beyond adversity.

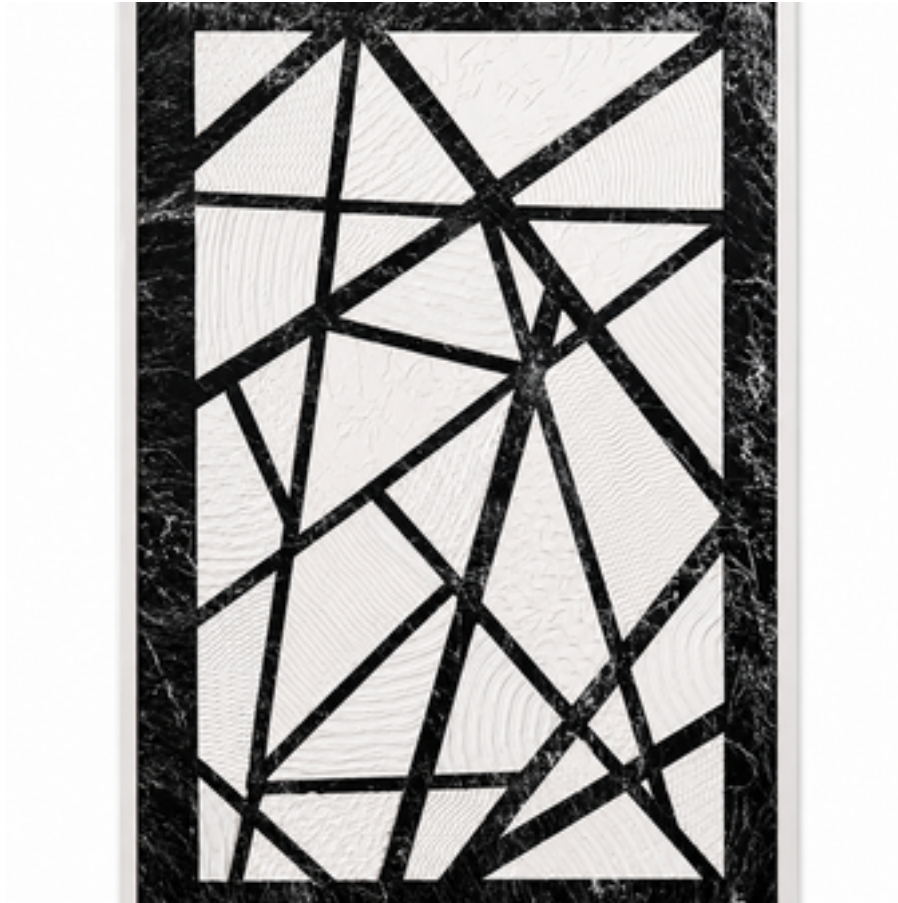

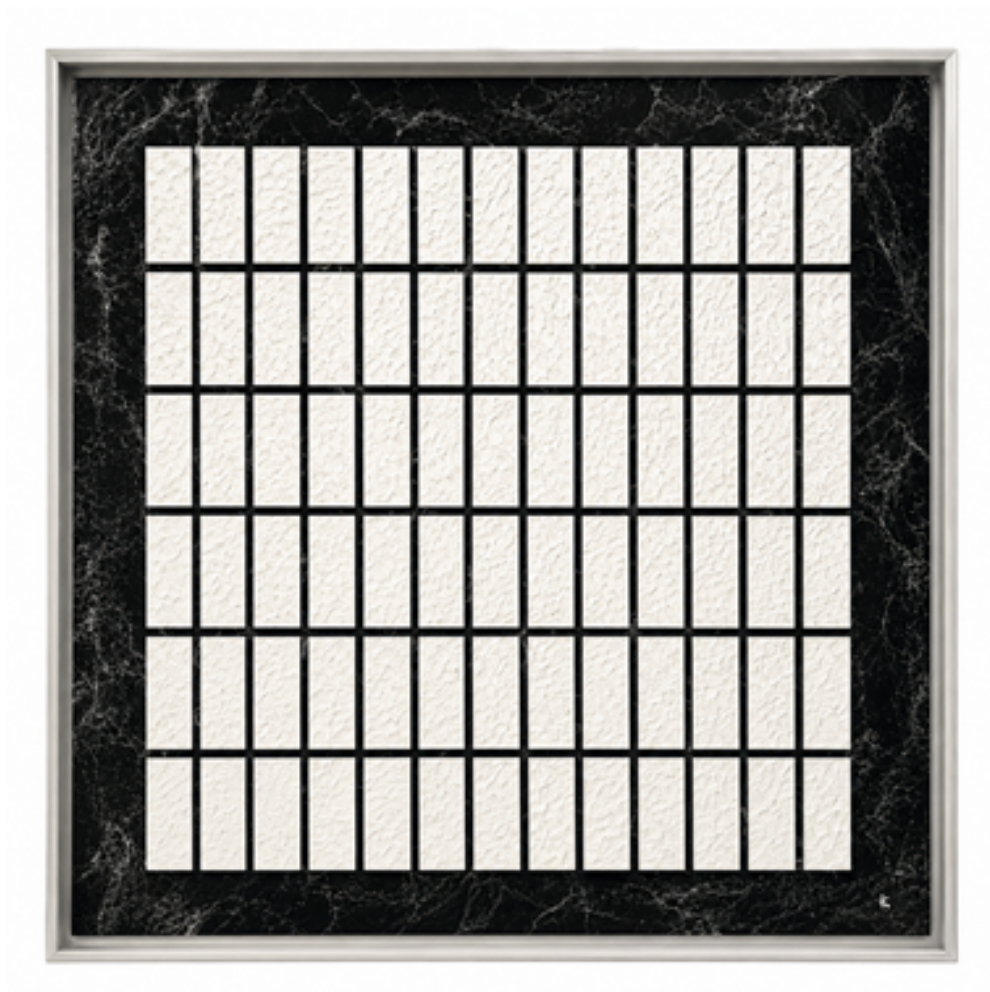
